After serving my Diocese for 15 years in 2018, I had an opportunity to come to the United Sates for a one year course in Chaplaincy at UCSF in San Francisco. Since 2020 to present I live and work in the Archdiocese of San Francisco at St. Isabella's parish as Parochial Vicar and Chaplain for Kaiser and Novato Community Hospital in San Rafael.

The Catholic Archdiocese of Arusha in October 1st 2023 will be celebrating 60 Years Jubilee of Faith since the Diocese was established started in 1963. The church works tirelessly to help the people especially the most vulnerable. We have an orphanage center that helps more than one hundred (100) children who lost their parents to HIV/AIDS. They need food, medication, and education etc. Kindly please consider supporting us in helping these children to better their future lives by your prayers and contributions.

Arusha Catholic Seminary: Is a Seminary in the Catholic Archdiocese of Arusha Tanzania - East Africa. The Seminary is enrolling young boys who have expressed interest in becoming Priests.
