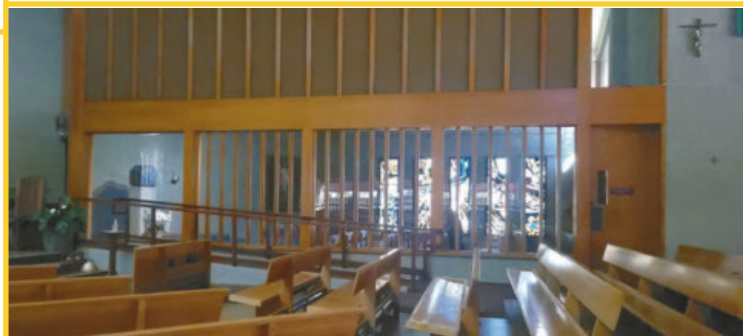

Mt 22:1-14

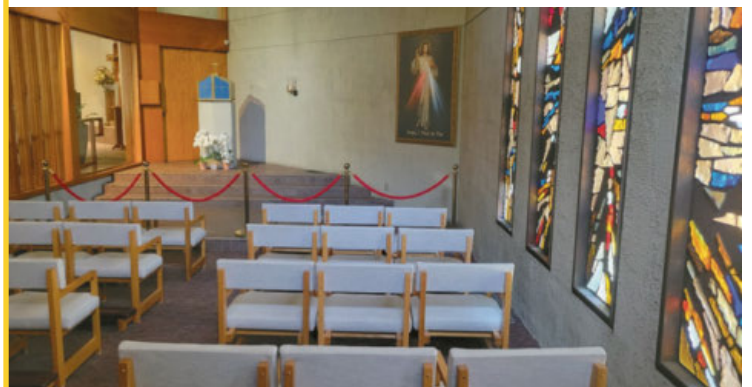

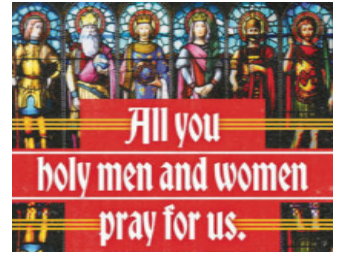

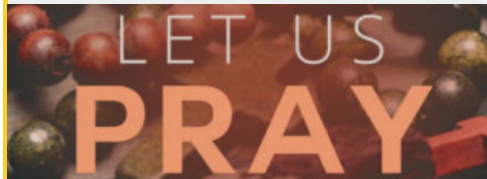
### Part Time Parish Receptionist

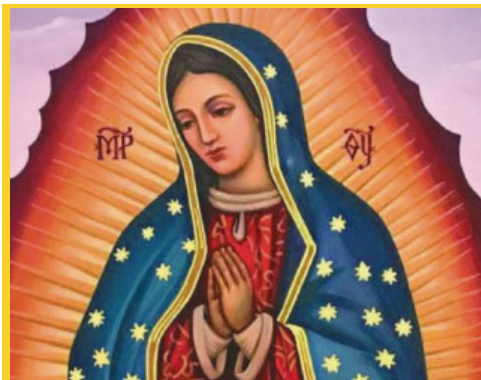

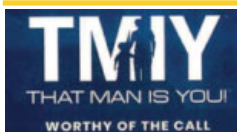

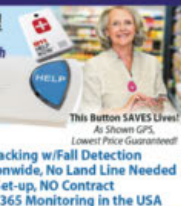
