Bishop Emeritus Brown Passes

Bishop Kevin Vann and the Roman Catholic Diocese of Orange community are saddened to announce the passing of Bishop Emeritus Tod David Brown.
Bishop Brown died Sunday morning at St. Joseph Hospital after being hospitalized. He was 86. Sustained and heartened by the knowledge of all who had been praying for him, Bishop Brown received the anointing of the sick and the Apostolic Pardon.

Bishop Brown, the third bishop of the Diocese of Orange, will be laid to rest in the St. Callistus Chapel and Crypts, which are being constructed beneath Christ Cathedral and are scheduled to be completed in 2024.

"I ask for prayers for the repose of Bishop Brown's soul and for the thanksgiving to God for his many years of ministry and evangelization. Let us pray: Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May he and all the faithful departed through the mercy of God rest in peace. Amen." said Bishop

A vigil is scheduled for Oct. 29 at 6 p.m. at Holy Family parish in Orange. The funeral Mass will be at 10:30 a.m. Oct. 30 at Christ Cathedral. Both will be livestreamed.

MESSAGE FROM THE BUSINESS MANAGER

Fellow Parishioners,

With the holiday season approaching and the final days of 2023 drawing near, you may be considering year end donations. As of today, we are almost at 90% of our PSA Goal of \$148,000. That may sound pretty good, but please consider the following. Every dollar over our goal comes back to

PSA is typically not something that we heavily promote. However, the two parishes nearest to us with very similar goals regularly double and even triple their PSA Donation Goals. Yes, St. Martin's and Santa Clara will bring in over \$300,000 respectively for their PSA funding. That translates to \$150-\$200K for their parish's general funds. That's close to or even better than what we net on Fiesta, minus all the hard work and volunteer hours.

One common criticism of the PSA program is that parishioners would rather give directly to the church rather than go through the diocese. Our initial goal supports programs like Catholic Schools, Seminarians and other outreach programs that you may already be donating to.

Thank you to those who have already given to our PSA. I do not want to "Preach to the Choir", yet all the funds that we have received so far come from about 15% of our registered parishioners. 


