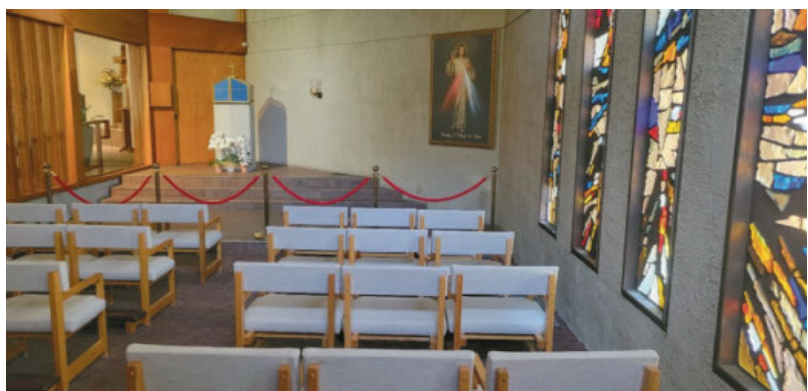
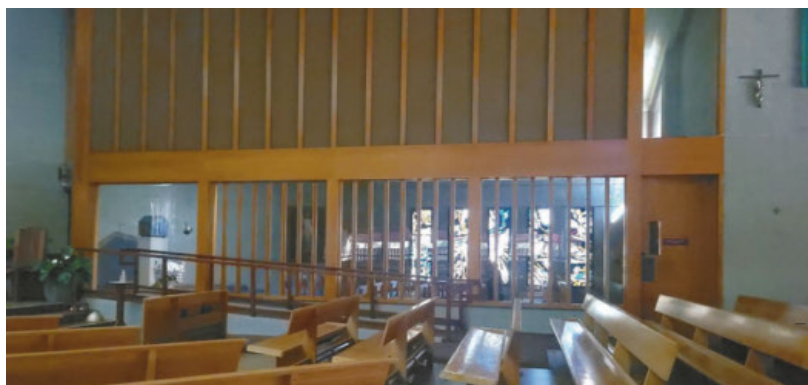
Bethlehem Christian Families - The Holy Land

November 18 & 19, 2023, the Bethlehem Christian Families will be here in the Courtyard to sell their hand carved religious articles made of olive wood. The sale of these precious articles supports their Church Mission, which is to maintain the roots and the existence of the Christian Families who are struggling to remain in Bethlehem.

At least 90% of the funds raised through these sales go directly to Christians living in the Bethlehem area. The proceeds will create more work which will help them to survive and stay in the Holy Land, since they have no other source of income and are dependent on the olive wood industry. 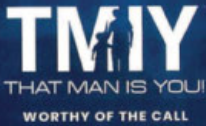

PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY



During the month of November we will be celebrating our 10 year anniversary, from 2013 - 2023!

We meet the first Tuesday of every month in Conference Room 1 from 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm. We welcome new members and gladly accept yarn and monetary donations.

If you know of someone in need of a prayer shawl (someone who is ill and in need of prayers, hope, and comfort), they can request one: (1) through one of our members; (2) call the parish office

and leave a message; or, (3) go in our website (<https://sanantoniochurch.org/ministries/prayer-shawl-ministry#information>) and check the box "Request a Prayer Shawl". We are a small group and if we run out of shawls, no worries, we will add the names to a list and pray we collect more shawls the following month.

Available Shawls: After disbursements of previously requested shawls, we have the following 48 shawls available for distribution:

Women – 31 shawls; 6 lap blankets

Men – 10 shawls

Children – 1 baby blanket; plus 7 baby beanies

The adult beanies will be shared with Saint Jude's Oncology Center.

In ten years, from November 2013 through October 2023, we have accomplished the following:

Increased members from an estimated 10-12 to about 50 active members today.

Collected 1,469 shawls and 190 beanies. In the past 12 months alone (November 2022 thru October 2023), we collected 499 shawls, an average of 41 shawls per month.

Supported: St. Jude, Choc Hospital's Neonatal Unit, and Respect Life Ministry
