



NICENE CREED

EASTER REFLECTION FROM DEACON BRETT

Brothers and Sisters in Christ: I pray that, as you reflect back on your Lenten journey, you experience a sense of joy with all that it provided to you. Perhaps you were able to completely embrace your commitment and kept it faithfully. Or you may have faltered a time or two. My hope for all of us is that, regardless of the outcome, we were drawn closer to Christ. Further, I pray that you stay on the path to Christ and deepen your relationship with him.

In the Gospel for Easter Sunday, we read that Peter and the other disciple, John, ran to see the empty tomb. Peter entered first and witnessed firsthand

Both Peter and John were drawn ever closer to Christ, despite the fact that their journeys were different. Peter denied Christ three times, yet became the Rock of the church and the first Pope. John stood by the cross with Mary and the other women. He was the only disciple that was spared a martyr's death. I can only imagine that both of them were ever-humbled and grateful for their respective journeys.

Therefore, I pray you find the same comfort that I do in path of Peter and John. Knowing that no matter what my journey to Christ has been or will be, He will be by my side. May Jesus' passion, death and resurrection be a beacon of hope for you on your continued journey to Him.
