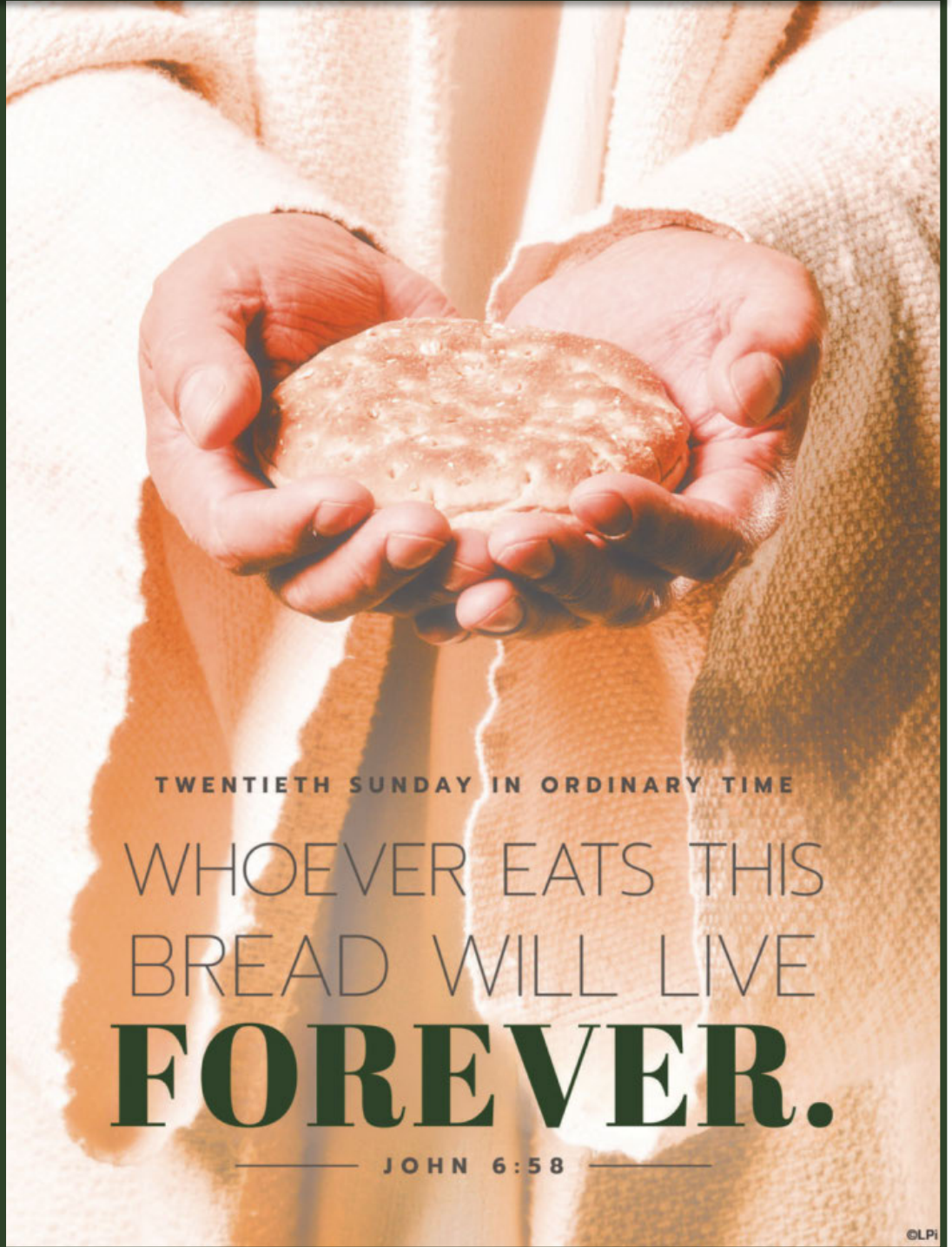

I can speak for Monsignor Tuan, our clergy, and our staff in thanking you, our parishioners, for graciously sharing your time, talents, and treasures with our church. We have teams of volunteers who have been sharing their time over the past few months preparing for our upcoming Fiesta... and don't worry, you'll all have opportunities to sign up and help during our recruitment weekends. Thank you Renee Gillespie and the Silent Auction team who are working daily! We have ministries that are thriving and other ministries that are being reestablished. A special thank you to Michelle O'Reilly and Erika Thiede for bringing back our Mom's Group!

Thank you to those who share their talents. Members of our Adult Choir and our Childrens' Choirs are rehearsing to bring joy to our weekend celebrations. Members of our Pastoral Council and Finance Council offer their talents in guiding the decisions of our parish. Thank you to the unsung heroes, of whom there are many, that work quietly and consistently to serve us all, specifically Jim Woodin with Hospitality, Scott Hervey in the Food Pantry, and Sue & Joe Curi with our Environment team that make our worship space most beautiful. As for sharing treasures, thank you to everyone who shares what they are able.

Again, our PSA Goal this year was \$148,000 and our internal goal was to have 1,000 families participate. Good News!... as I am writing this, 262 families have helped us exceed our monetary goal. That means that **every dollar that is donated** to the Pastoral Service Appeal for San Antonio de Padua from now until the end of the year will come back directly to our church. Last year, we received \$34,000 back in rebates. Regardless of donation size, if we come even close to our internal goal of 1,000 families, we will share in great rewards.

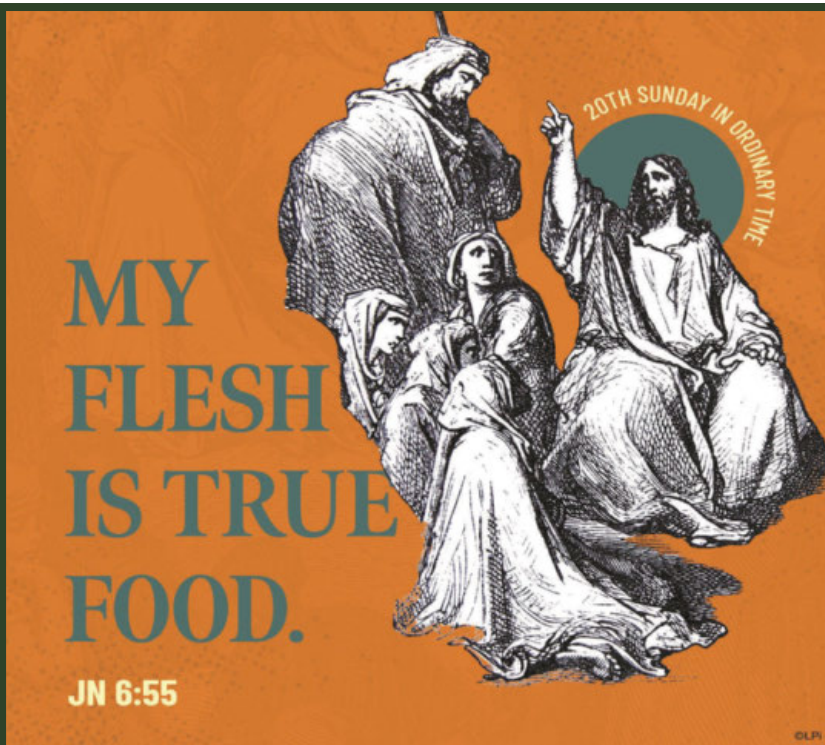

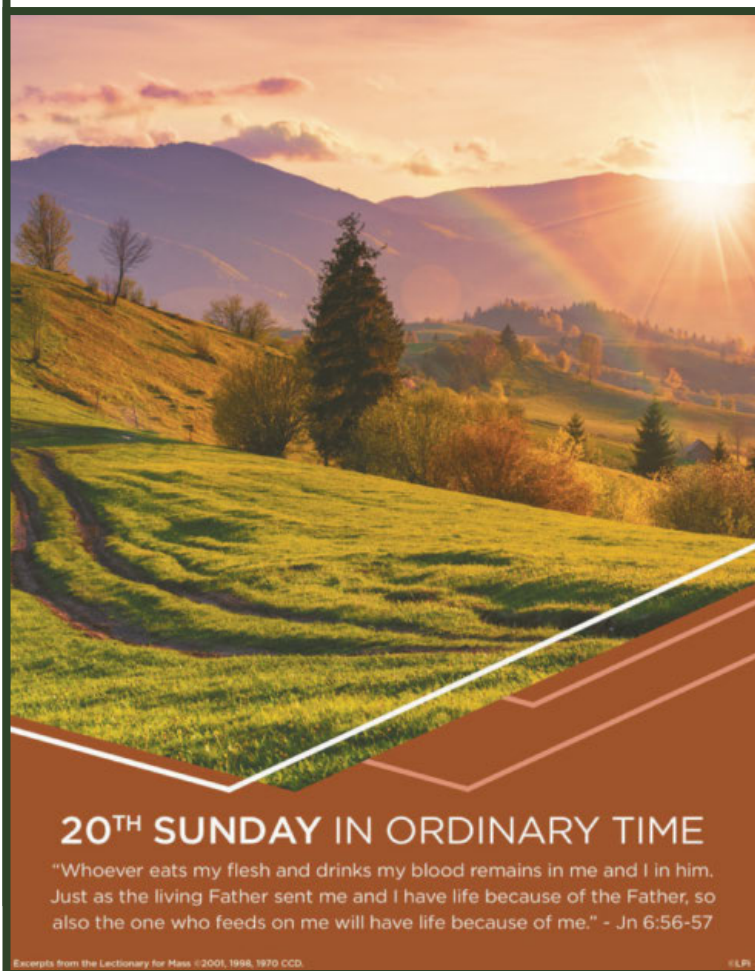

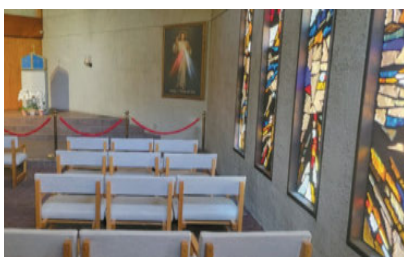
SACRISTANS URGENTLY NEEDED

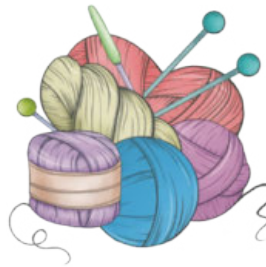

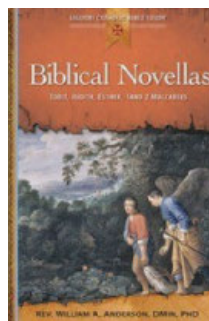
RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY

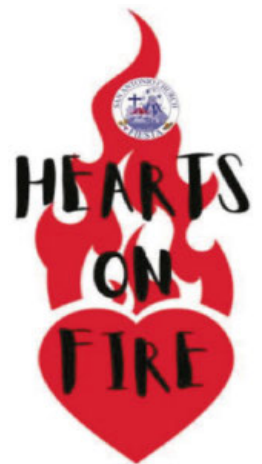
