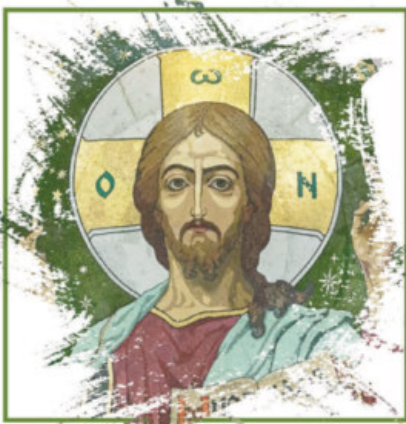

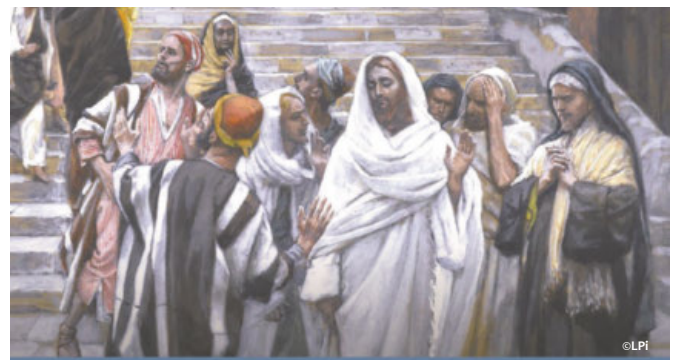
## ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

## ANOINTING OF THE SICK



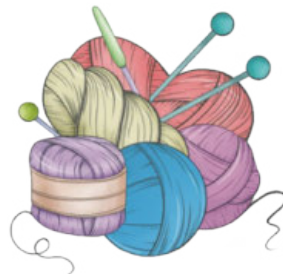
